Its up to all of us to be careful

How to protect

- Set a unique secure password on EVERY account
- Only visit sites you trust by typing in the URL
- Try to avoid clicking on links – especially from sources you don't 100% trust
- Hover over URL to see true destination
- Treat email with a questioning mind
 - Read, Re-Read, Ask then Act on important emails
 - Check the headers to ensure its coming from the real person
 - Question is it legitimate
 - Ring the person requesting to confirm

When Travelling

- Only connect to a trusted Wifi
 - Try not to connect to public wifi - especially in busy places like airports and shops
 - use a personal 3G device / hotspot instead
 - Or trusted signal in a hotel

How to protect at Home

- Set a secure password on all devices connected to the internet
 - Fridge / TV / Baby Monitor
 - Phone / iPad
 - Modem / Router
 - Computers
- IoT – Anything connected to the 'Internet of Things' as above but also includes a broad range of products you don't actually see – such as electronics and sensors built into things.
- Use a service like OpenDNS at home – free

Mobile Devices

- Ensure you have a PIN
- If stolen - Ability to remote wipe if you have work email on your phone (talk to SPD IT about how to set this up)
